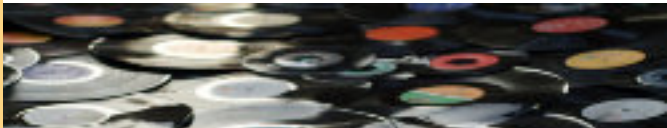
*The old home town looks the same
